Opening Business:

- ❖ Reportable event: A group of coho fry (734) at the fish hatchery died after a nozzle providing water became clogged. The tank did not empty of water, however, without the constant flow of water there is not enough oxygen in the water for the fish. The facility people have decided to put nozzles on with bigger diameter holes on all the flow thru tanks to prevent this from happening in the future. This event was reported to OLAW.
